



MII is designed to accelerate the transition of promising technologies with significant commercial potential from five Maryland academic research institutions: Johns Hopkins University, Morgan State University, and University of Maryland College Park, Baltimore and Baltimore County campuses. The program is designed to promote commercialization of intellectual property and to leverage each institution's strengths.



WHO

All Qualifying Universities are eligible to apply for funding for the Technology Assessment Phase of the Program. University Start-ups that have licensed technology from the University within twelve (12) months of applying for a Program award, and are located in Maryland, are eligible for the Company Formation Phase.



WHAT

MII funds up to \$265,000 through two phases of the program:

- Technology Assessment - Technology Validation and Market Assessment, nine months, up to \$115,000
- Company Formation - Commercial Launch, nine months, up to \$150,000



HOW

Applications are accepted on a bi-monthly basis and are due by 5 PM on the 1st business day of each submission month. The MII program requires each applicant to engage with a Site Miner, the individual who is selected by the MII program from the participating University, to help ensure a strong, competitive application.
